\* it's necessary to prove it by an EU digital COVID certificate or by a written confirmation. Only vaccinations approved by EMA are accepted. Certificates are valid 14 days after the end of the vaccination for the period of 270 days. This period can be extended by the booster shot. Certificate for children between 12-18 years is not time-limited.

\*\* it's necessary to prove it by an EU digital COVID certificate of Covid-19 recovery. The certificate is valid 11 days after the positive test for the period of 180 days.
