Ranking of BUT 2012-2018

The objective for the future is to improve our position in both rankings, including reclaiming our former position in the THE rankings of the best universities: realistic expectation for the near future is to return to the TOP 1,000 (position in the previous two years); in regard to the QS ranking, we would like to move up fifty ranks, which was our position three years ago. The basis for improvement is internal in its nature: greater interest of BUT faculties and component parts in the ranking of BUT and closer co-operation with the rectorate. In this regard, the situation is improving; BUT introduces methodology and possible procedures using multiple platforms; relevant faculties and component parts are also advised on measures they can implement in order to improve the rankings, which includes more efficient recording of data as well as provision of various required databases (e.g. provision of contacts to potential evaluators). However, both rankings require significant improvement in publishing activities in terms of higher citation rates of papers, or better co-operation with experts from other, preferably foreign universities, on publications. BUT is also faced with the task of ensuring better control of the outputs recorded in the Scopus database, which is one of the sources of data used by the organisers of both main rankings.

BUT continues to monitor the forthcoming methodology changes of both rankings and, in accordance with these changes and based on communication with advisors on the part of the rankings organisers, tries to implement smaller changes in relation to the nature of the submitted data. The meetings of the Czech University Rankings Group and sharing of experience among the participating universities also provides better insight.
