Course Registration

• Student should register for courses online at <u>http://ktis.kookmin.ac.kr</u> during the registration period. Students can add and drop courses on the Kookmin Total Information Systems (KTIS) website (http://ktis.kookmin.ac.kr/) with their student number.

Student ID Number and guideline for course registration will be sent to you in January by students' e-mails. If you fail to register during the period, you can do it during the course add/drop period upon arrival in Korea with the help of the staff.

- * Standard Load: 17~19 credits per semester depending on the major
- * Recommended Load: 12~15 credits during a semester

Course Adjustments (Add/Drop/Change)

- During the first week of each semester, students can change their classes on the Kookmin Total Information Systems (KTIS) website (http://ktis.kookmin.ac.kr/).
- Students can choose to drop or add a course to their timetable.

b Housing Fee

- During semester: 705,600 KRW (approximately USD 590) for one semester
- During vacation: 6,300 KRW (approximately USD 6) per day + Deposit 50,000 KRW) Deposit nonrefundable if students leave during the middle of vacation
- ▷ Meal Plan: 403,200 KRW (approximately USD 340) per semester (Optional)
- Living Costs: approximately 300,000 KRW (approximately USD 250) per month
- * Living costs depends on each student.
- * Fees are subject to change without a prior notice.

• Important information

- Smoking, drinking, cooking is strictly forbidden in the dormitory.
- Entering dormitory and/or floor of the opposite sex is strictly forbidden.
- Other useful information
- Students should prepare their bedding (Can purchase in Korea).
- Cost for meal on campus ranges from 2,500 KRW (approximately USD 2) to 10,000 KRW

(approximately USD 9)



How to Get to KMU from the Incheon Int'l Airport

□ Incheon Int'l Airport → Kookmin University

• Take airport limousine 6101 and get off at Jeongneung bus stop. Bus Fare: 15,000 KRW (approximately USD 13)

At the Jeongneung bus stop, cross the street and take bus 171, 1213, or 7211 for Kookmin University. Or take a cab to campus
Bus fare: 1,150 KRW (approximately USD 1)
Taxi fare: approx. 3,500 KRW

\Box Incheon Int'l Airport \rightarrow KMU (By Taxi)

• When arriving in groups taking taxi from the airport can be a good option. $\$

The taxi fare will be approximately 70,000 ~ 80,000 KRW
